





Sustained Investigation




WASC is the Western Association of Schools and Colleges.



(Technology, Innovation, Design, & Entrepreneurship). Their symbol of the wave was also included.


For the logo, I made a combination logo of a pictorial and wordmark.

Brochure


The "Apples, Apples, Apples!" brochure is an informational brochure about the differences between red, green, and yellow apples & what deserts/foods they're best suited for.


"Feel The Crunch!" is an extension to the apple project, and is an article about 3 fun facts about apples.

Frank Stella

The Frank Stella Project was creating designs inspired by Frank Stella based off of the architecture of my school, Beckman High School.

I based my piece from the stairs, the handrails, and the school doors.

To create my own twist, I decided to split the designs up into 3, created asymmetry by placing the cardboard pieces unevenly, and made my designs more abstract.

Letters


The Name piece was created by taking my name and cutting them in random directions and sizes.

Scrambling and shuffling the pieces, I placed them however I desired, allowing my creativity determine which piece went where.

I utilized space, creating an asymmetrical work by crowding the pieces mostly towards the left.

The Idaho piece was created through incorporating patters based off of famous landmarks of Idaho such as Idaho Falls, the State Capitol, and mountains.

Using simple, geometric shapes, I created the basic shape of the state. 3 separate stencils for cyan, magenta, and yellow to silk screen were used. By overlapping the colors, secondary colors were created.

For the Holidays, the Beckman Ornament was created by laser cutting acrylic. The middle piece was hung on its own through a small jump ring, creating a simple, hollow design. The letter "B" stands Beckman and the number 19 represented the year (2019).

The Upcycle Project was to create a piece out of scrap materials and random items around the house to create something gallery ready.


I used an old shoe box, a zipper, buttons, & magazine papers to create, "A Snake Spilling Sssecrets".



I chose to go with a modern design as I related it to my logo, which was geometric and sans serif.






Throughout my Sustained Investigation, I drew out my thought process in every round, based on the changes I made.


